

Six!

Equipment Needed: Pencil or Pen, dice, index card or half sheet of paper

How to play:

This is an exciting little game that will turn a quiet room into a room of noise and laughter. Create groups of 4 to 6 players. Give each group one die, one pencil, and an index card for each player.

Place the pencil in the center of the group and give the die to a selected player to start the game. Rolling of the die should be in order around the circle. Nothing happens in this game until a six is rolled.

The player that rolls a six must yell "SIX", pick up the pencil and start to write numbers from 1 to as high as he can get before another player rolls a six, yells "Six", and takes the pencil away from the player writing and starts to write his own numbers.

The first player to write to 50 is the winner. All rolls should be quick to stop the person from getting to 50.

A frequently asked question: Do we have to start over, from 0, the next time we roll a six? The answer is NO. Continue to write your numbers from where you were when the pencil was taken from you.

This game gets loud and the players get very excited, but remind them that the pencil has a point and to be careful when taking it from another player.
